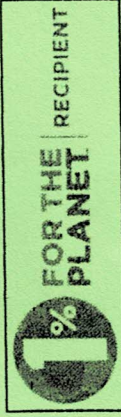

Featuring the 327-acre Worster Lake, hundreds of acres of wetlands, restored prairies and rich woodlands, the Park is a haven for wildlife and provides unique opportunities to observe nature up close.

Today, Potato Creek is six-square miles of parkland, including the 160-acre Swamp Rose Nature Preserve. Numerous trails, the nature center, a class A campground, family cabins, a quality swimming and beach area, the horseman's campground and trails, paved bike trails and a mountain bike trail, a youth tent area, boat launches, boat rentals, fishing piers, and much more make this park an outstanding recreational facility.

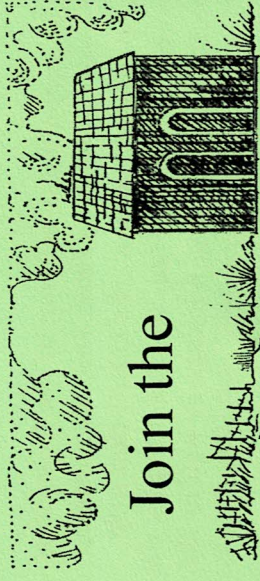
